

### Introduction

We'll be using **Sign-Up Genius** again for our SLRE Volunteers to sign up for trips for our 2021 season!


Each one of you (with email) will need to have an account set up, if you don't have one already. Once you have created an account, you will have access whenever you need it to edit or delete your sign up or sign up for additional slots.

Here's how it works. An invitation will be emailed to you to sign up for trips.

Then.....

When you open your email, your invitation will something look like this.


Click the **Sign-Up** box.



The schedule opens and each day will look like the following section. **3** slots will need to be filled for each trip. The level of care for each organization is noted by **Low**, **Medium** or **High** next to the location name, to help you determine a good fit for your ability. There is also a brief description of each available slot. Choose your slot and click Submit and Sign-up at the bottom.




As a new user, this is the screen that pops up next for you to fill in your information - this is a one-time 'fill in'. You can also choose to have confirmation emails and calendar files sent to you from here. Phone number is a required field.




### **Step 3 (b)**

Once you have an account, and when you login, this is the screen that will be displayed asking if you'd like a confirmation email sent.



A Thank You pops up to let you know you have been signed up and that a confirmation email has been sent to you. You can also automatically add this to your calendar by clicking one of the calendar buttons provided. Then, click Return to Sign Up to see yourself on the schedule.



The Front Mate position has now been filled by SLRE Duluth. Note the pencil, swap and 'X' icons below SLRE Duluth. Since you now have an account, you can return anytime to edit, swap, or delete the sign-up.

\*Every time you create, edit, swap or delete a sign-up, you and Bob V. will receive confirmation emails of the actions. Also, if Bob feels there may be an issue with level of care for the passenger & the assigned volunteer, he will give you a call to discuss.

Once you are back to the sign-up screen, you can sign up for additional slots before logging out.


# **Before Signing Up**

Choose trips along with an alternate or two that you'd like to sign up for. You won't know what is available until you open Sign Up Genius.




#### Access

After you receive an invitation and your account has been created, you can go to the SLRE website for a quick link to Sign-Up Genius on the Volunteer page. (Alternately, you can go to <a href="www.signupgenius.com">www.signupgenius.com</a> and login from there.



### **Login Screen**

Whenever you login after your account is created, your screen will look like this. In the "Items I Signed Up For" section, you will see the links to the trips (each month will have its own link). Click on one of the links to volunteer, edit or delete a sign up.



Again, a confirmation email will be sent to you and to Bob noting those changes.
